

Combined BS-MS in Computer Science Application Form 2008

Admission Criteria

Undergraduate Computer Science majors with a minimum GPA of 3.0 in Computer Science at the end of the first semester of their junior year are eligible to apply for the combined BS-MS program. A letter of recommendation from one of their Computer Science professors is required. Students should have taken all required Computer Science courses up to CMPT 371. The Graduate Record Examination (GRE) is not required. A committee that includes the undergraduate advisor, the graduate program coordinator, and the graduate committee will review applications at the department level. Applications recommended by this committee will be reviewed by the Graduate School for final approval. Students enrolled in the program are expected to meet all standards established by the graduate school. Students who have completed a B.S. in Computer Science are not eligible for this program.
